



## 2019 Mileage Rates

Taxpayers have the option to use the standard mileage rate or the actual cost of using their vehicle for a business deduction. This year mileage rates for business and medical use have increased. According to Irs.gov, the new standard mileage rates are as follows:

- 58 cents per mile driven for business use

- 20 cents per mile driven for medical (and for moving for military on active duty)
- 14 cents per mile driven in service of charitable organizations

Please note that none of these new rates will affect your 2018 tax returns.

The Internal Revenue Service will start to process 2018 tax returns on January 28<sup>th</sup>, the same day electronic filing begins. Even with the current government shutdown, returns are expected to be processed timely and refunds distributed without delay. The tax deadline this year is Monday, April 15<sup>th</sup>.
